Male Mentor Games Night

Format:

- Teams are made up of a boy and his Dad/Guardian/Older brother/Mentor.
- Teams will compete in one activity per session.
- There will be two 45-minute sessions.
- All games will be in a round robin format.

Activity Descriptions:

Rock Climbing: Test yourself by climbing the 8-metre high pinnacle rock climbing wall. Under the expert and watchful eye of qualified instructors, 2 pairs can climb and abseil down the wall.

Cricket: Teams face a maximum of four overs with the other teams fielding and bowling. Modified cricket rules.

Basketball: 2 x 2 games for 5 minutes each.

Soccer Skills: Penalty shoot out and dribbling contests around an obstacle course.

AFL Skills: Longest kick and a handball competition.

Volleyball: Pairs compete on court.

Ultimate Frisbee: Fun competitive team game.

Lego Robotics: Use your mind to build and construct robots from lego.

Tennis: Doubles matches with one set up to 4 games.

Table Tennis: Doubles matches with games to 15 points.

Chess: The cerebral game played in pairs against another pair.

Carpet Bowls & Darts: Carpet bowl games played up to a score of ten

points. Darts games counting backwards from 100.

Board Games & Cards: Cards, Scrabble, Trivial Pursuit, Mastermind, Backgammon.

Boys, Blokes and Books: A series of fun, word and book based activities, including a treasure hunt. Prizes to be won.
